LEAD Peninsula is a community and civic immersion program, which offers a comprehensive, behind-the-scenes look at the components that make the Peninsula run efficiently and effectively and prosper economically. Special circumstances will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

All participants who fail to meet the above requirements are subject to dismissal from the class – with no refund of any portion of the tuition. A participant's failure to meet these requirements will be reviewed by the Virginia Peninsula Chamber, and a determination will be made. Interested persons are expected to be aware of these requirements prior to submitting an application to be in the LEAD Peninsula program.
